LAW 27 – INSUFFICIENT BID

Acceptance of Insufficient Bid

1. Any insufficient bid may be accepted (treated as legal) at the option of offender's LHO. It is accepted if that player calls.

Take Time to Absorb the Facts

Do not offer 25A

Very Important LHO may Accept IB Informed Choice Law 10C1



2. If a player makes an insufficient bid out of rotation Law 31 applies.



(b) except as in (a), if the insufficient bid is corrected with a comparable call (see Law 23A) the auction proceeds without further rectification. Law 16C does not apply but see D following.

Law 23: Comparable Call

Did not see RHO's Call

Saw the call but thought it was at a level lower Responded to or asked a question at wrong level:

Stayman after 2NT

4NT Blackwood

King Ask

Transfer after 2NT

2. except as provided in B1 above, if the insufficient bid is corrected by a sufficient bid or by a pass, the offender's partner must pass whenever it is his turn to call. The lead restrictions in Law 26B may apply, and see Law 72C.

Even if a 27B1 Correction Available

3. except as provided in B1(b) above, if the offender attempts to substitute a double or a redouble for his insufficient bid the attempted call is cancelled. The offender must replace it as the foregoing allows and his partner must then pass whenever it is his turn to call. The lead restrictions in Law 26B may apply, and see Law 72C.

Suppose the X or XX Is not Comparable

Two Withdrawn Calls to Consider for Possible Lead Restrictions.

4. if the offender attempts to replace the one insufficient bid with another insufficient bid the Director rules as in 3 if the LHO does not accept the substituted insufficient bid as A1 allows.

LHO May Accept First IB Second IB Withdrawn Possibly Subject to Lead Restrictions

LHO May Accept Second IB First IB Withdrawn Possibly Subject to Lead Restrictions

Neither Accepted

Back to 27B3

Partner Must Pass Whenever 26B 72C

If offender advises table of his intended bid - -

- - UI to Partner Director has no interest in the cards held

Only the system being played

Be careful not to impart information about the offender's hand to the table

Talk to the offender about system away from the table

Offender may be told what the ruling would be for a call he is considering.

Director does not approve authorise or suggest possible replacement calls

1S 2C 2NT What may opener deduce?

Responder could have 6-9 not 10-12 Responder might not have a club stopper If Opener has 15 hcp. May he pass 2NT? YES

Partner may correctly deduce that the insufficient bidder has a weaker hand however a good score must be one that was possible without assistance from the insufficient bid or the score may be adjusted. Likewise, he may bid on and find a lucky good score not found at other tables.

May need to consider 27D "Non-offending"

May need to consider 27D "Non-offending side damaged".

## Insufficient Bid in a Nutshell

When an insufficient bid has not been accepted, offender has three options:

- 1. Replace with a bid of the lowest sufficient level that specifies the same denomination(s) and the auction continues with no rectification; or
- 2. Replace with a comparable call (of same/similar meaning) and auction continues with no rectification; or
- 3. Replace with any other bid or pass, but then partner must pass whenever it is their turn to call, and lead restrictions may apply.
